


Reread the text


Read fast or slow to match the text


Use punctuation marks, commas, and quotations

Read with emotions






Do the <u>words</u> match the <u>pictures?</u>

Chunk the Letters and sounds together

Skip the word and go back to read it again



Guess the word and see if it makes sense




Choose a "just right" book
